- Uncompetitive and disbalanced transport tariff system
- Inefficient railway operations, shortage of wagons
- Unused river potential
- Luck of e-logistic approaches (single window, et.)
- Customs procedures bureaucracy



GOVERNMENT COORDINATION IN LOGISTICS

- Mechanism that would allow for different Agencies and Ministries involved in logistics and transport to come together and better coordinate their actions
- Formulation of more efficient Logistic Policies
- Adoption of more integrated Multimodal Approach
- Implementation of National Logistic Strategy
- Elimination of Logistic bottlenecks

ANALYSIS OF EFFECTIVE INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS

Permanent Committees

- Commitment under a sub regional trade and/or transport agreement
- Cambodia, Malaysia, Thailand and Viet Nam under the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Framework Agreement on Facilitation of Goods in Transit

<u>Temporary Committees</u>

- Coordination on specific projects or programs, by setting up special task forces, working groups or units to coordinate the implementation of projects or programs
- Special Inter-ministerial Task Force for Investment Climate Improvement and Trade Facilitation in Cambodia

Case based coordination approach

- Coordination among agencies on a case-to-case basis: particular measure, regulation or an agreement relating to trade and/or transport facilitation initiated by one government agency
- Establishment of committees to coordinate and deploy multimodal masterplans




FUNCTIONS & ACTIVITIES


