I'm an American of Moldovan origin, based in Ukraine and the region for twenty years. I led investments for WNISEF/Horizon Capital, Dragon Capital and now my own firm, 4i Capital Partners. I've served on numerous commercial boards of directors and currently serve on boards of Portmone, Venbest and Prime Group (being Chairman on all) as well as on the Board of Bank Credit Dnepr as an independent director. I previously worked for Credit Lyonnais in Paris, National Bank of Moldova and World Bank in Washington, DC (covering MENA region). I also taught electrical engineering as well as money, banking and financial markets at university level and plan to return to teaching activities at some point in his career.

I have been involved in various social activities: was one of the founders of AmCham Moldova, am President-founder of Alliance Française of Moldova (for more than 25 years) and Co-Chairman of Business Advisory Council for Southeastern Europe and Eurasia. I also currently serve on the Board of Governors of Pechersk School International (PSI) in Kyiv, being its Chairperson.

I received MA in Economic Policy Management from Columbia University, NYC and MA in Physics from Moscow University. Knight of Légion d'honneur of France.
